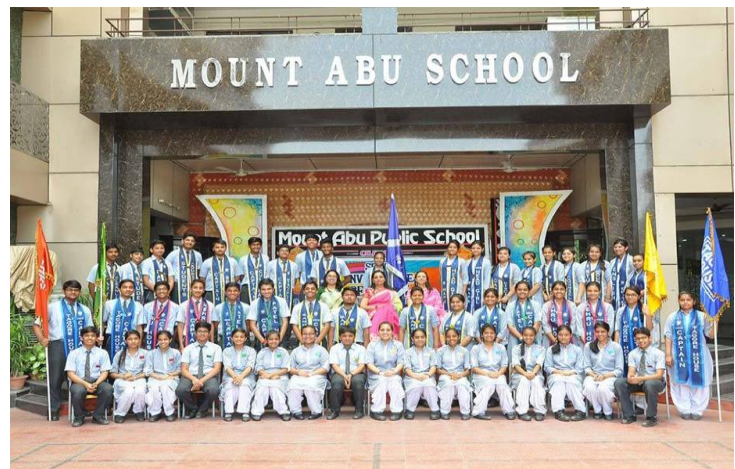
INVESTITURE CEREMONY
