SAFETY AND SECURITY

FOR THE STUDENTS

- The **reporting time** for walkers and van students to school is **7:50am sharp** in the morning and **departure time** from the school is **2:00p.m**.
- If your ward is not adhering to the above mentioned timings, **the school gates will be closed** and the school does not hold any responsibility for his/her safety outside the school.
- Walkers accompanied by parents are also supposed to be dropped and picked at the designated school gate. No parent is allowed to go beyond the marked boundaries.
- Entry in the school premises will be strictly allowed on showing parent
 I- card only.
- The school campus (classrooms and labs, entry, exit, school premises, coridoors and other vital sites) are under the surveillance of closed circuit television to keep a close watch on happenings in the school which is necessary for safety and security of the child.
- The school offers state of the art security solution. The school has tied up with Uro Security, a premier firm for safety and security. Every visitor to the school needs to get himself verified using the mobile number. Hence anyone entering the school premises is verified and checked before accessing the entry in the campus.
- Students are not allowed to carry scissors/ any sharp object/ cutters/ white fluid to school. Parents are requested to be sure that children are not carrying all this in their bags.
- The support staff has been hired by external agency Miraz Security after thorough verification.
- All the drivers and conductors and the other staff members are experienced and verified by Police.

- We have women employees near washrooms for the security in the washrooms.
- Messaging the parents class IX onwards about the absenteeism is in practice to ensure the students may not bunk the school.
- Proper medical room is there with experienced staff nurse and necessary equipments and medicines required as first aid.
- No student is allowed to / from the school for shot leave / half day for any of the reason.
- For Disaster Management, regular mock drills are organized for students to be safer if any emergency occurs.

IN THE BUSES

- GPS- Global Positioning System and cameras have been installed in each and every bus as a vital security feature for the safety and security of every child using school bus service.
- All the buses used for transportation of students are own by school itself.
- All the drivers and conductors are experienced and verified by Police.
- School bus is prominently written on the back and front of the bus carrying school children.
- The windows of the bus are fitted with horizontal grills.
- The school buses are fitted with speed governors with maximum speed limit is limited to 40 kmph.
- The bus possesses fire extinguisher at emergency exit door.
- The seats of the school bus are made of noncombustible material.
- Transport manager is entrusted with the responsibility to ensure the security of school children.
- Every bus driver and conductor possesses the required license for their duties and functions.
- The students are always accompanied in the bus with attendant & a teacher
- The drivers are always dressed in uniform of grey trouser and jacket.
- The bus is equipped with First Aid box also.
- Seating capacity in the buses is also as per the guidelines.
- The record having details of the students are always with the bus conductor.
- The driver of the bus is equipped with mobile phone to be used in case of any emergency.
- The school buses are parked inside the school campus at the time of boarding and deboarding of the school students.

FOR PRIVATE VAN USERS

- The reporting time for Van users to the school is 7:50 a.m. sharp in the morning and departure time from the school is 2:00 pm.
- If your ward is not adhering to the above mentioned timings, the school gates will be closed and the school does not hold any responsibility for his / her safety outside the school.
- Kindly do the needful for the safety and security of your ward ensuring the timely arrival & dispersal by his/her van driver.
- The van driver must be holding legal driver license issued by the concerned authority.
- The van driver must have police verification.
- The van driver is carrying students permitted according to the seating capacity of the van
- The van has grilled windows
- He is following the speed limit, traffic lights and rules.
- The private vans commuting school children must possess the status of commercial vehicles and all the required documents.
- Vans with private numbers are not allowed to be used for school children. So these vans cannot ply on the road in the absence of the above mentioned formalities.
- The van drivers are dropping children outside the gate around 7:15 while it opens at 7:30 AM, which is quite risky and the school can't be held responsible for any of the unwanted incident if it happens.
