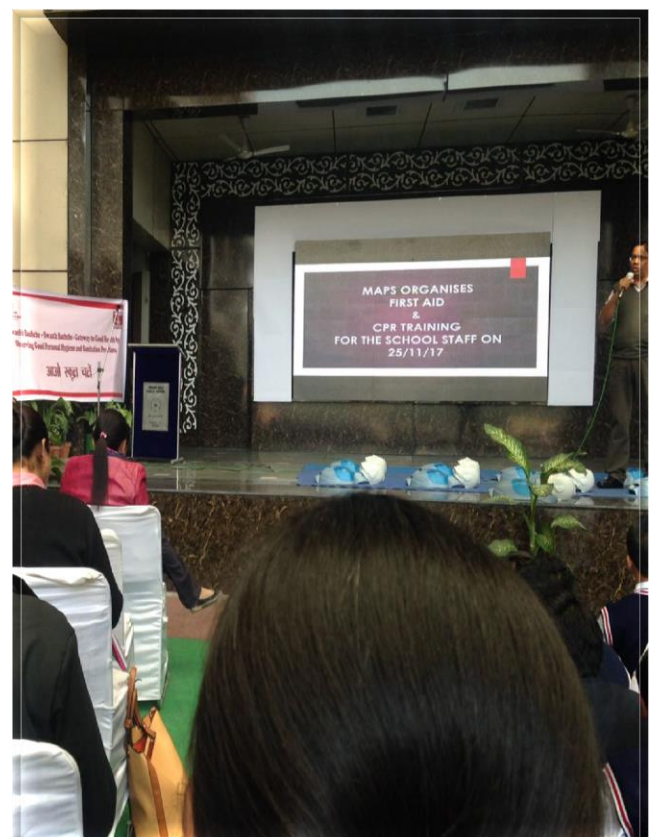


WORKSHOP ON FIRST AID AND CPR

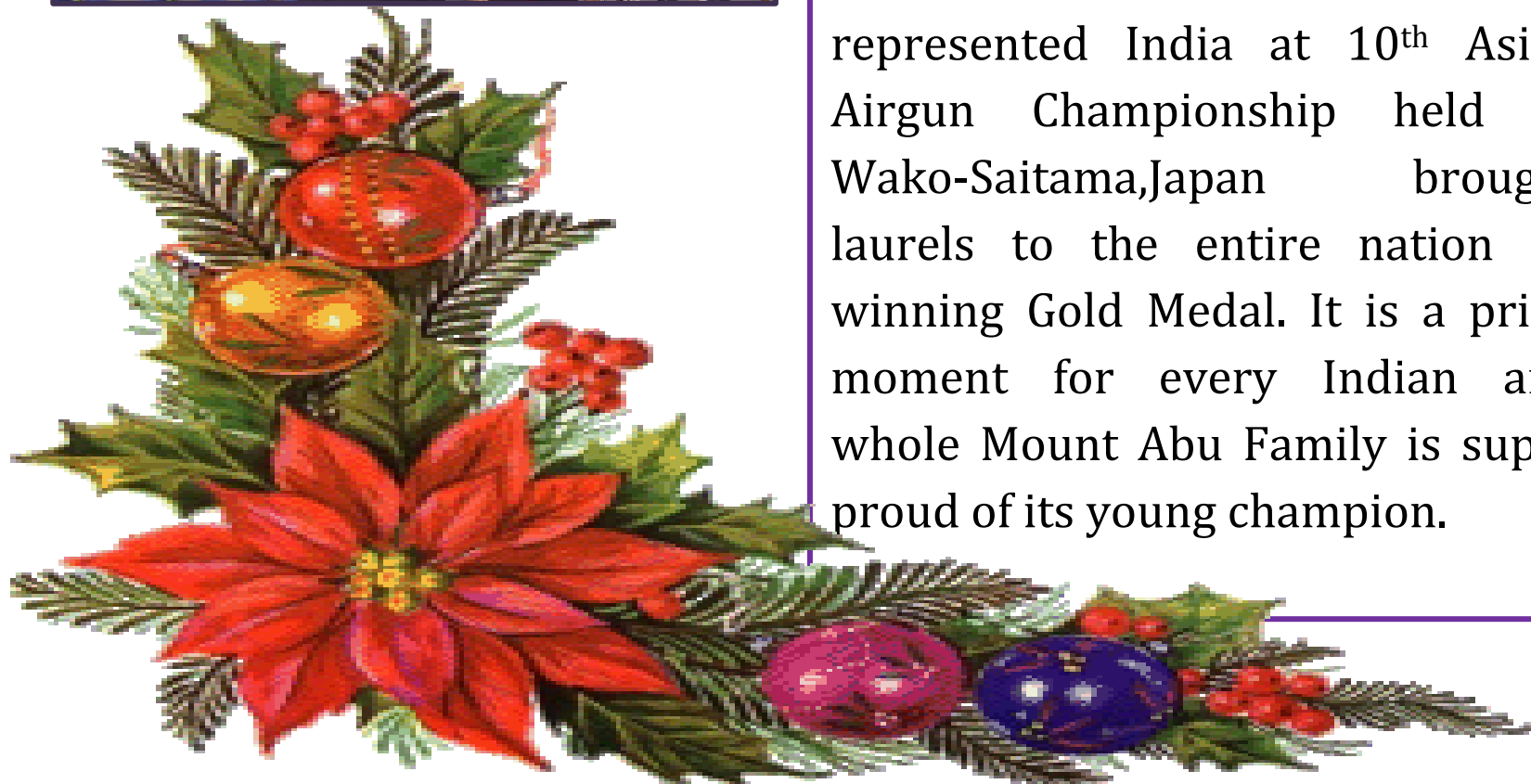
Microsoft Showcase School
