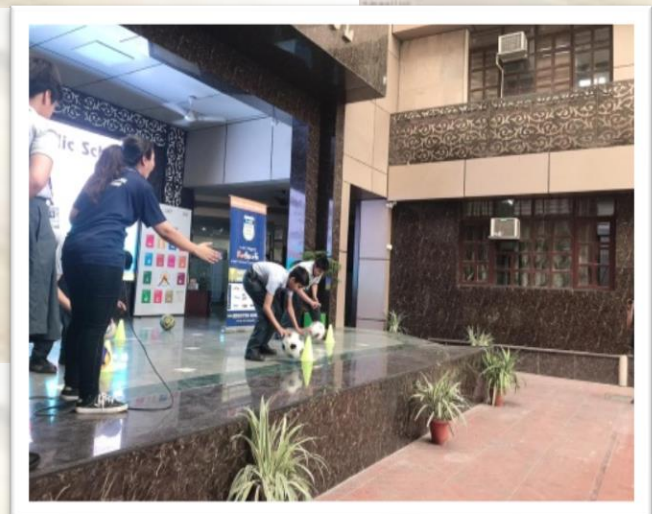
SESSION ON ETHICAL VALUES

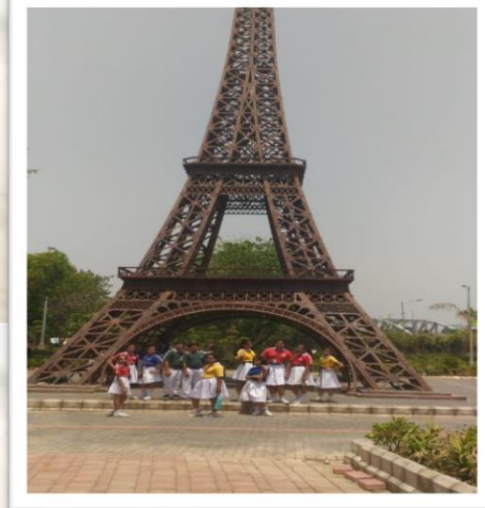
WEBINAR ON ANTI BULLYING

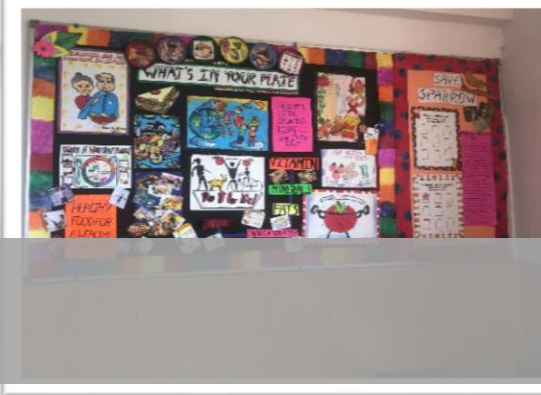


EDUCATIONAL VISIT TO WASTE TO WONDER
