



Dear Parent

As per the circular received from CBSE/AFF./Circular-8/2017 dated: 23.2.2017 mentioning the guidelines of Hon'ble Supreme Court regarding **the safety of School children in the school bus**, which needs the serious attention of parents also for safety of their ward. The School ensures all facilities recommended by CBSE as follows-

1. School bus is prominently written on the back and front of the bus carrying school children.
2. The windows of the bus are fitted with horizontal grills.
3. The school buses are fitted with speed governors with maximum speed limit is limited to 40 kmph.
4. The bus possesses fire extinguisher at emergency exit door.
5. The seats of the school bus are made of noncombustible material.
6. **Global Positioning System (GPS) is already installed in the buses and CCTV and message to the parent is already in the process to be installed within a few days.**
7. Transport manager is entrusted with the responsibility to ensure the security of school children.
8. Every bus driver and conductor possesses the required license for their duties and functions.
9. The students are always accompanied in the bus with attendant & a teacher
10. The drivers are always dressed in uniform of grey trouser and jacket.
11. The bus is equipped with First Aid box also.
12. Seating capacity in the buses is also as per the guidelines.
13. The record having details of the students are always with the bus conductor.
14. The driver of the bus is equipped with mobile phone to be used in case of any emergency.
15. The school buses are parked inside the school campus at the time of boarding and deboarding of the school students.

In our endeavor to provide the safety to our school children in the school buses, the school has tried to equip the school buses with the facilities as per the guidelines from CBSE and we expect parents to take care of the same and opt for school bus for the their ward's safe travelling to and from the school.

Note :

The private vans commuting school children must possess the status of commercial vehicles and all the required documents. Vans with private numbers are not allowed to be used for school children. So these vans cannot ply on the road in the absence of the above mentioned formalities. Please pay serious attention.

Secondly, the van drivers are dropping children outside the gate around 7:15 while it opens at 7:30 AM, which is quite risky and the school can't be held responsible for any of the unwanted incident if it happens.
