CBSE NATIONAL ARCHERY CHAMPIONSHIP 2024

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. What are exact dates of championship?

Ans. The tournament will take place from October 22 to 26 2024

2. What is the reporting day and time?

Ans. Reporting Day is October 21, 2024. Timing is from 02:00 pm onwards.

3. On which day will the championship get over and at what time?

Ans. Tournament will be over on October 26, 2024. It is expected to be over by 06:00 pm. However, it depends on the time of completion of the matches.

4. Are Coaches and Managers permitted to enter in the competition area?

Ans. No, Coaches and Managers are not permitted to enter inside the playing area as per CBSE guidelines. This has been decided in order to ensure silence so that participants can concentrate on the matches.

5. Will parents be permitted to enter inside the campus?

Ans. No, parents will not be permitted to enter into the school campus.

6 What arrangements are there for coaches and players in the school?

Ans. Coaches and players will stay along with their teams as intimated in the guidelines issued by CBSE.

7. What are the urgent documents to be sent well in advance through email to the host school?

Ans. Travel Plan, Consent and Participation Form/ receipt of CBSE sports fees should be sent well in advance through email to the host school.

8. What are the documents to be produced at the time of registration?

- a) Travel details
- b) School Flag 01
- c) Archery Equipment
- d) Group Photograph counter signed by the Principal
- e) Unique I.D. Number proforma
- f) Original Age proof of Participants
- g) CBSE Registration card attested by the Principal
- h) Proof of CBSE Annual Fee Payment made.
- i) Copy Of online Participation Entry Proforma duly filled in.
- i) Identity cards of the Participants as per CBSE Norms.

9. Will conveyance be provided to all participants? If yes, which are the places where the school will provide pick up and drop facility.

Ans. The host school will do the needful for the pick-up of participants on arrival and drop off at the time of departure. A representative, bearing a placard titled MOUNT ABUPUBLIC SCHOOL, from the host school, will be available at New Delhi Railway Station, Ajmeri Gate Side (Near New Delhi Metro Station), Bus Stand, ISBT. Those arrivingby Flight can take Metro to New Delhi Railway Station.

Note: No conveyance will be provided at the Airport

10. If the participating school makes its own arrangement to reach the school, whom should it contact for route guidance?

11. Is Boarding & Lodging compulsory?

Ans. Not compulsory

12. What are the charges of Boarding & Lodging?

Ans. lt is Rs. 500 per head per day.

13. How much is the Security Money?

Ans. Rs. 2000/-

14. What if the team gives it consent for participation and cancels it at the last minute?

Ans. In such a situation, the particular school will have to deposit a penalty of Rs. 1000/- to the host school.

15. What if a team wants to stay at hotel?

Ans. In case a team wants to stay in a hotel at Delhi, Rohini, they need to communicate the same to the host school via email. It may please be noted that in such cases, the host school will not take the responsibility of providing them to and fro conveyance and food / refreshments. They themselves have to manage it.

16. Are parents/relatives allowed to stay with the participants in School?

Ans. Only the mother escorting the participant, in the absence of a lady escort from the school, will be allowed provided that a group photograph comprising of players, manager/coaches/mother and the Principal is submitted at the registration desk on arrival.

17. Some suggestive hotels / places at Delhi near to Rohini?

Ans. You may Google it for hotels in Rohini, Paschim Vihar, Pitam Pura, Saraswati Vihar etc. which are in the vicinity of the school.

18. Will there be any meal facility for parents?

Ans. No, there will no facility of meals for parents as it is on payment basis for the players / coaches / managers only.

19. Will there be canteen in the school?

Ans. Yes, there will be canteen facility in the school, the menu of which will be provided during arrival.

20. What will be the Menu?

Ans. The menu for all event days has been prepared as per the guidelines given by the CBSE

21. What outfits are to be carried by participants/team?

Ans. The participants of a particular school should wear similar sports uniform with the name of their school printed at the back of their T-shirts/shirts.

22. How many teams are eligible for participation?

Ans. Top one teams under both categories of each age group are eligible for participation.

23. In case of any complaint or emergency, whom should the participating school contact?

24. Will locker facility be available to safeguard the valuables?

Ans. No, the school will not be able to provide any locker facility for your personal purpose. Kindly ensure that you do not carry valuables and the important papers are lockedwithin your suitcases / kit.

25. What is the procedure of refund of security?

Ans. As instructed by the CBSE, refund of the security deposit will be done while departure. However, in case of any major loss/damage caused to the host school, security amount would be forfeited.

26. Am I entitled to avail balance amount of boarding & lodging charges, in case of early departure?

Ans. Neither reimbursement nor balance, which was paid for meals, would be returned in case of early departure.

27. What if I failed to bring school flag?

Ans. All participating schools are requested to bring the school flag as it is mandatory during March past in the Opening Ceremony.

28. What if our team could not report to the host school even after the submission of consent form?

Ans. In case the participating school fails to report even after the submission of consent / confirmation of participation, a penalty of Rs.1000/- would be imposed, as per the guidelines issued by the CBSE.

29. Will managers/coaches get any certificate from Hosting School?

Ans. Yes medal will be awarded to managers / coaches of all participating schools

30. Will personal photography be permitted on campus/during events?

Ans. Personal photography is strictly prohibited on campus,

1. What are the exact dates of the championship?

3. On which day will the championship conclude and at what time?

Ans: The tournament will conclude on **October 26, 2024,** expected to be over by **6:00 PM,** depending on the completion of the matches.

4. Are coaches and managers allowed in the competition area?

Ans: No, coaches and managers are not permitted in the playing area as per CBSE guidelines to ensure participants can concentrate on their matches.

5. Will parents be allowed on the school campus?

Ans: No, parents will not be permitted to enter the school campus.

6. What arrangements are in place for coaches and players?

Ans: Coaches and players will stay with their teams as outlined in the guidelines issued by CBSE.

7. What urgent documents must be emailed to the host school?

Ans: The following documents should be sent well in advance via email:

- Consent and Participation Form/receipt of CBSE sports fees

8. What documents must be presented at registration?

Ans:

- Group Photograph counter-signed by the Principal
- Unique I.D. Number proforma
- Original Age proof of participants
- CBSE Registration card attested by the Principal
- Proof of CBSE Annual Fee Payment
- Copy of online Participation Entry Proforma duly filled
- Identity cards of participants as per CBSE norms

9. Will transportation be provided to participants?

Ans: Yes, the host school will provide pick-up and drop-off for participants at specified locations. A representative will be available at:

- New Delhi Railway Station (Ajmeri Gate Side)
- Bus Stand (ISBT)

Note: No conveyance will be provided at the Airport.

10. Whom should a school contact for route guidance if arranging its own transportation?

11. Is boarding and lodging compulsory?

Ans: No, it is not compulsory.

12. What are the charges for boarding and lodging?

Ans: The cost is **Rs. 500 per head per day.**

13. What is the security money amount?

Ans: The security money is **Rs. 2000.**

14. What if a team cancels participation at the last minute?

Ans: A penalty of **Rs. 1000** will be imposed on the school for last-minute cancellations.

15. Can a team choose to stay in a hotel?

Ans: Yes, teams wishing to stay in a hotel must inform the host school via email. The host school will not provide transportation or meals in such cases.

16. Are parents or relatives allowed to stay with participants at school?

Ans: Only the mother escorting the participant is allowed if no lady escort from the school is available, and a group photograph with the Principal must be submitted at registration.

17. Can you suggest hotels near Rohini?

Ans: Please search online for hotels in Rohini, Paschim Vihar, Pitam Pura, or Saraswati Vihar.

18. Will there be meal facilities for parents?

Ans: No, meal facilities are available only for players, coaches, and managers on a payment basis.

19. Will there be a canteen in the school?

Ans: Yes, there will be a canteen, and the menu will be provided upon arrival.

20. What will be the menu for meals?

Ans: The menu will be prepared according to CBSE guidelines.

21. What uniforms should participants wear?

Ans: Participants should wear similar sports uniforms with their school's name printed on the back.

22. How many teams are eligible for participation?

Ans: The top team from both categories of each age group is eligible.
